

RIBBED SCARF with a Twist

This reversible scarf features knit-two, purl-two ribs accented with two-stitch cables that alternate from the first two to the last two stitches of the knit ribs. A simple knit-one, purl-one border prevents the long edges from curling.

FINISHED SIZE About 6½" (16.5 cm) wide and 43" (109 cm) long, unblocked.

YARN Alpaca with a Twist Baby Twist (100% baby alpaca; 110 yd[100 m]/50 g): #3006 burgundy heather, 3 balls.

NEEDLES Size 7 (4.5 mm). Adjust needle size if necessary to obtain the correct gauge.

NOTIONS Markers (m); tapestry needle.

GAUGE 10 sts and 12 rows = 2" (5 cm) in St st.

CO 52 sts.

Set-up row: [K1, p1] 3 times, place marker (pm), *k4, p4; rep from * to last 6 sts, pm, [k1, p1] 3 times.

Rows 1—8: [K1, p1] 3 times, slip marker (sl m), *k2, RT (k2tog but leave sts on left needle, knit the first st again, slip both sts off needle); rep from * to last 6 sts, [k1, p1] 3 times.

Rows 9—16: [K1, p1] 3 times, sl m, *RT, k2; rep from * to last 6 sts, [k1, p1] 3 times.

Rep Rows 1—16 until piece measure about 43" (109 cm) from CO, ending with Row 8 or 16 of patt. BO all sts.

Weave in loose ends.
